Newly Redesigned Fellowship Program Provides Mentorship for Assistant, Associate and Emerging Documentary Film Editors from Underrepresented Backgrounds and Experiences

Open call for submissions begins FEBRUARY 1, 2022 Received-by application deadline is MARCH 20, 2022

The Karen Schmeer Film Editing Fellowship is a year-long group mentorship program for documentary assistant, associate and emerging editors from historically underrepresented backgrounds and experiences. The program will consist of monthly small group meetings with seasoned documentary editor mentors. This year we are excited to announce a hybrid program, both in-person and online, allowing for applicants from across the country. Applications will be accepted during our open call period from February 1 to March 20, 2022.

- Applicants should be people who consider themselves committed to pursuing careers as documentary editors (as opposed to fiction editors or directors/producers who edit).
- Applicants must have at least two credits as an assistant, associate, additional, co-editor or editor on a feature documentary (60 minutes or more), but no more than three credits as a co-editor or editor.
- Applicants must come from historically underrepresented backgrounds and experiences including those facing discrimination or barriers due to race, ethnicity, religion, socioeconomics, immigration, disability, age, gender, sexual orientation, and/or gender identity.
- Applicants must be based in the United States and reside there from September 2022 to September 2023.
- Applicants should be able to attend monthly meetings in-person if they reside
 in NYC or Los Angeles (pursuant to local health guidelines) and monthly
 virtual meetings if they reside in other areas of the U.S..
- Applicants cannot be enrolled as students in undergraduate or graduate programs during the fellowship year.
